<b>OPD services</b>	<p>As per Government of India instructions on social distancing, and other infection control practices at workplaces and hospitals, efforts were made to reduce OPD services (by curtailing registration timings) from March 19, but the average attendance remained around 4000 patients per day (+4000-6000 attendants). On March 24, due to lockdown measures, non-emergency OPD services were curtailed to ensure all patients were screened for covid-19 before further evaluation and treatment. Emergency outpatient and inpatient services continue in all speciality departments (ENT, Ophthalmology, Psychiatry, Dental, Medicine, Pulmonology, Dermatology, Surgery, Obstetrics, Pediatrics, Radiation oncology, Orthopaedics, Anesthesiology and Critical Care, Emergency Medicine) and superspecialty departments (Cardiology, Cardiac Surgery, Neurology, Neuro Surgery, Paediatric Surgery, Medical Oncology, Surgical Oncology, Medical Gastroenterology, Surgical Gastroenterology, Immunology, Plastic Surgery, Nephrology, Neonatology and Urology). All laboratory and imaging services are functional. Maintenance haemodialysis, cancer treatment and blood bank services are continuing uninterrupted.</p> <p>Beginning on April 24, OPD services have been started using teleconsultation (yesterday's numbers are listed below).</p>
<b>Covid Hospital block</b>	<p>A new 300-bed exclusive hospital block with intensive care units (with 36 ventilators, monitors) and 142 beds with piped oxygen supply has been created at the instruction of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India. This facility is to serve as a referral facility for high-risk Covid-19 patients requiring intensive multi-specialty care or ventilatory support.</p>
Covid Task Force	<p>JIPMER constituted a multidisciplinary Task Force consisting of faculty from various disciplines (including clinical and laboratory departments), administration, nursing, engineering and technical staff on March 20, 2020. This Task Force used to meet on a daily basis, and currently meets every alternate day. Many members join on tele-conferencing.</p>

Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs)	SOPs for 15 activities prepared to ensure smooth operation of all covid-19 related operations, including specific services and flowcharts for infection control, screening, treatment, laboratory services, departmental management and mortuary services have been prepared, and are available for use by other hospitals on the JIPMER website.
Enhance Country's testing capacity	JIPMER has been working as a mentor Institute for several southern Indian states, helping to establish and monitor testing facilities for 88 medical colleges in Puducherry, Tamil Nadu, Karnataka and Andhra Pradesh.
Testing	In addition to diagnostic and surveillance testing for Puducherry, testing services are extended to Tamil Nadu and Madhya Pradesh at request of MOHFW
Committee formed for exit plan	Under the chairmanship of Director, JIPMER, a committee is executing plan for restoring the phased resumption of services, while ensuring all government guidelines are followed.
Rapid Response Team	Based on orders of Government of India, JIPMER has formed a multidisciplinary Rapid Response Team to assist the Government of Tamil Nadu to help overcome the Covid-19 problem in the Chennai region.
